









Top 20 Calendar Art














Paint the Town REaD is an early literacy community program that encourages the community to read, talk, sing and play with children from birth, to develop the skills they will need for reading and writing.





The overarching theme of the sessions is focussed on healthy mind, body and soul with a holistic approach to strengthen positive fathering patterns and strategies.

We have had a wonderful start to the year at Every Body Play Callington. Our playgroup imbeds the PEEP Learning Together Program where we weave new skills and knowledge into our playgroup sessions. The children love exploring the different activities each week. Our Playgroup Shop has been particularly popular as we watch the children engage in wonderful parallel play, buying and selling things to each other and to all the parents, caregivers and facilitators.

We also offer sensory play each week as an opportunity for the children to practice their fine motor skills and gain experience with different textures. The children love tipping, poring and sometimes even sitting in our sensory trays!

Everyone is always welcome! The playgroup is suitable for all ages, birth to school age. Every Body Play Callington meet every Tuesday during school term at Callington Recreation Centre from 9am.




LOCAL LINKS
